Qualifying Customers

Qualifying customers for the commercial lighting rebate program include Puget Sound Energy electric customers on commercial rate schedules, other than retail wheeling customers. Retail wheeling customers may utilize their Sch 258 Large Power User Self-Directed Program incentive allocation for commercial lighting rebates through the Sch 258 RFP process.

Compact Fluorescent Lamps (CFL) & Cold Cathode

Qualifying CFL products are required to be ENERGY STAR® listed. Specialty Lamp categories are the following: dimming, three-way, reflector, candelabra, globe, and cold cathode lamps (cold cathode lamps do not have to be ENERGY STAR® Qualified, but must have at least a two year warranty and produce at least 35 lumens per Watt)

Non- Qualifying lamps for this Program:

- Pin based lamps (unless they are coupled with an adapter)
- Any non-screw in lamps or lamps specific to a certain type of specialty non-CFL fixture

Incentives for installation of these energy saving products are available through other Business Energy Management programs.

LED Exit Signs

LED Exit Signs must have at minimum a 5 year Warranty, be 5 Watts or less, and replace existing incandescent or CFL Exit Signs to qualify for a rebate.

Ceramic Metal Halide (CMH)

Qualifying CMH products must be self ballasted screw-in type certified by Underwriters Laboratories (UL) or another nationally recognized testing laboratory.

Integral Light Emitting Diode (LED)

Qualifying Integral LEDs are recessed down light fixtures or retrofit products or integral LED lamps which are ENERGY STAR® qualified or on the Utility Qualified list held by the Lighting Design Lab. If the product is on the ENERGY STAR® qualified list for Commercial Fixtures or Integral LED Lamps, the product is automatically qualified. If the product is not on the ENERGY STAR® Qualified list, the customer or contractor must follow the procedures

Low Wattage T8

Qualifying Low Wattage T8s are 25-28 Watt 4' T8 Lamps which are CEE listed and are part of a group re-lamp to convert the facility to a more efficient lamp stock. PSE's Low Wattage T8 Rebate is a "one time only" rebate opportunity. A search will be made in PSE's project database prior to any new rebate being paid. If a low Wattage T8 rebate is found on the same account or at the same address further research will be conducted to determine eligibility (e.g. re-lamp of an additional building served by a common meter, a different floor, etc.) Repeat applications in the same spaces are not eligible.

- Note – reduced wattage lamps will also reduce light output. Do not do this conversion if you perceive your space is currently underlit.
- Note – reduced wattage lamps are not designed to run in ambient temperatures below 60 degrees F.
- Fluorescent light bulbs contain a very small amount of mercury, do not place used fluorescent lamps in the garbage. For proper disposal methods

Qualifying Lighting Controls are commercial grade occupancy sensors and/or timers.

I understand that PSE may inspect the existing and/or retrofitted lighting and that it does so on a regular basis, and I hereby agree not to unduly or unreasonably limit PSE's ability to conduct any such inspections.
